

# PTC Meeting Minutes

**Tuesday, February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

PTC President Autumn Spayer called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance. PTC Board members in attendance were Spayer, Turczyn, Costello, Aleksy and Eitutis. Absent were Sarver, Freed, Glover and Buffmack. Introductions were done by those in attendance.

- January Secretary Minutes was read by President Spayer and approved.
- The treasurer's reports were given for January by Treasurer Amy Eitutis and approved.
  - ○ Checking- \$1,956.35
  - ○ Savings- \$54,712.47
  - ○ Combined- \$ 56,698.52
- A discussion was held with those in attendance regarding school assemblies to which Mr. Ziegler and Mrs. McDonald stated that there were currently non planned. President Spayer offered help from the PTC should they decide to have any.
- Grants for 8<sup>th</sup> grade to Scene 75 in the amount of \$2244.14, 5<sup>th</sup> grade to Medieval Times in the amount of \$ 4858.65 (with \$2517.40 being returned) and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade to Gamma Phi Circus Morning Show in the amount of \$1,455.00 were explained by President Spayer. All grants were approved by those in attendance.
- Appreciation Days were discussed for Administrative Professionals, Nurses Day and School Lunch Heros. Gift certificates for \$25.00 were decided on for those Days by those in attendance.
- Teacher Appreciation Week will also receive Amazon gift cards and lunch will be provided to both Northview and Parkside schools on Tuesday, My 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- Amy Glover states that volunteers are still needed for Family Bingo Night on. A discussion on what time the night's events will occur happens. It is decided on that the doors will open at 5:30, bingo will be from 6:00-7:00 p.m. with Mayor Kolowski and his wife emceeding the event and the announcement of prizes/raffles will begin at 7:00 p.m.
- President Spayer states that no one has reached out regarding the positions for the 2025-2026 PTC Board.
- Treasurer Eitutis go over the findings for bylaws for other surrounding schools. JFK school in Spring Valley is the only one that had bylaws listed and offers them for handouts to those in attendance as well as information on other schools that have a PTC in place.
- The group discusses the donations for bingo night and also how to go about asking for donations.
- Donna Aleksy discusses the Read-A-Thon, and it is decided that it will cost more than to hold the event; therefore, it will not be held. The group discusses different options for bookshelves for the library. Suggestions are offered by those in attendance.
- The Ties & Tiaras event, to be held on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025, will be an Under the Sea theme. Heather Costello reminds those in attendance that volunteers are still needed.
- President Spayer states that for the month of January \$35.00 was earned through the Box Tops for Education program. President Spayer encourages everyone to utilize the program.
